The timber sale area is located east of Route 721 (Newtown Road), 1.3 miles north of St. Stephens Church in King and Queen County, as shown on the attached sketch.

1. Timber is offered for sale by single payment sealed bid. Bids will be opened at **10:00 a.m.** on **Thursday December 7, 2017 at the office of Forest Resources Management, Inc.** Mail or FAX bids will be accepted but must be received prior to bid date. Mail bids should be marked: SEALED BID –Smithfield Tract and mailed to Forest Resources Management, Inc., 7840 Richmond-Tappahannock Highway, Suite 200, Aylett, Virginia 23009.
2. Purchaser to have 18 months from date of contract closing.
3. No seed trees to be left. **There are approximately 25 merchantable trees that are to be reserved and are not part of the sale, these trees are double banded with orange flagging.**
4. Seller reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids.
5. **The purchase price shall be payable in full upon receipt of a Timber Sale Contract on or before December 21, 2017.**
6. Purchaser must submit evidence of liability and workmen's compensation insurance prior to commencing harvest of the timber. Minimum liability coverage shall be \$1,000,000.
7. Buyer must comply with Best Management Practices (BMP's) for timber harvesting. No timber is to be harvested from the Streamside Management Zone (SMZ).
8. A \$1000 escrow deposit will be required from the buyer.
9. Submission of a bid constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the client's Timber Cutting Agreement. This Agreement is specifically designed to meet the various legal requirements of the owner. If you wish to review a copy of the Timber Cutting Agreement for this sale please contact our office.
